Who or what is the PSCA?

The Association was formed in 1968 by the property owners with the following objectives in mind:

- To create better fellowship and promote cooperation between all members for their mutual benefit and pleasure.
- To promote general improvement of the community safety and welfare.
- To promote recreation facilities and recreational activities.
- To maintain and/or improve the roads and recreational areas.

The association is a non-stock corporation, registered with the Commonwealth of Virginia and governed by the laws of Virginia as set forth in the Code of Virginia.

What does membership in the PSCA mean?

Here are the Top 5 reasons to join the Piankatank Shores Civic Association this year:

1. Your dues provides funds to maintain the neighborhood roads and recreation centers. The PSCA maintains the neighborhood roads. This year, the association has an aggressive plan to maintain roads and to continue to upgrade our REC areas.
2. Once you join the association, you are welcome to use the recreational areas. Have a seat on the private beach and enjoy the playground. Or picnic at one of our multiple tables and grills. The neighborhood association maintains four recreations centers that are *available for PSCA members only and their accompanied guests*.
